CPOMS : Programming your U2F USB Key

To program your CPOMS U2F usb key...

- 1. Log into CPOMS.
- 2. Navigate to 'Account Settings' along the top bar of the screen and select the 'Security keys' tab.



3. Under the USB Security Keys section, enter a name for the new key when prompted (this is your choice, anything descriptive will do), then click 'Add new key'.

Web Authentication is a convenient way to log in to CPOMS using a USB key device. You can purchase these from CPOMS. Conveniently they'll also work with other applications you may use such as Dropbox and Google.

4. Click 'OK' if prompted to allow the security key setup, as shown here:
